New Reception: Applications for Reception class next year close tomorrow on 15th January 2022, you need to have applied via: <u>Primary school places - Essex County Council</u> All applications to St Alban's will additionally require a SIF to be completed which can be found <u>here</u> on our website or requested from the school office.

Punctuality: It is important that your child attends school on time every day, unless there are exceptional circumstances, every school day counts. Children's learning starts at 8.55am, please ensure you allow plenty of time for your morning school journeys to ensure your child arrives on time.

Twice weekly LFT: With the rise in COVID-19 infections in primary school age children, we encourage you to help limit the spread of the infection by testing your child twice-weekly. You can collect Lateral Flow Test kits from your local pharmacy using one of the codes provided <u>Here</u>

With the change in rules can we ask that if your child has a positive Lateral Flow Test you log it immediately on the GOV website found <u>Here</u> and send the result to the school.
