
How to Pray the Rosary

 - 6. Announce the Second Mystery and pray one Our Father

The prayers of the Rosary

Sign of the cross:

In the name of the Father and of the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen

The Apostle's creed:

I believe in God, the Father almighty,

Creator of heaven and earth,

and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,

who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary,

suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried;

he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead;

he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty;

from there he will come to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church,

the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,

the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

First Glorious Mystery

The Resurrection of our Lord

Matthew 28:5-6

The angel spoke, "Do not be frightened. I know you are looking for Jesus the crucified, but he is not here. He has been raised, exactly as promised."

Pray that you and your family may have faith in God

Second Glorious Mystery

The Ascension into Heaven

Luke 24: 50-51

He then led them out near Bethany, and with hands upraised, blessed them. As He blessed, He left them, and was taken up to heaven.

Pray that Jesus may bring comfort to those who are sad

Third Glorious Mystery

The Descent of the Holy Spirit

Acts 2: 3-4

Tongues of fire appeared which parted and came to rest on each of them. All were filled with the Holy Spirit.

Fourth Glorious Mystery The Assumption of Mary

Judith 13:18

The Coronation of Mary

Revelations 12:1
