This half terms topic is all about Dinosaurs! Each week you should choose at least one activity to complete and hand in on Wednesdays- **this works out as 6 each half term**. The activities suggested below will last for this half term - tick them off as you complete them. You can choose any activity you like – they do not have to be done in a particular order. Be as creative as you like with your learning.

Your child will be able to bring in their learning if it is something they have made. If they wish to share any written or photographic work, they can do so via their Teams notebooks. We will ensure to send out the links, username and passwords in due course. Please do let us know if you are having any issues with this.



Your child will still need to complete Maths Abacus/Active Learn activities online each week, plus continue learning their weekly spellings and read daily.



Writing	<u>Imagine</u> Imagine a dinosaur egg appeared in your house or garden! Write a short story about how you would care for the egg and what would happen if it hatched?	<u>Diary</u> Imagine you lived in prehistoric times, write a diary about what you see, what you might encounter and what events might have happened!	<u>Poem</u> Write and illustrate a poem inspired by dinosaurs. You may wish to use a poetry style you have recently learned about.
Research	<u>Research</u> Research dinosaurs (it can be anything to do with them!) using the internet or books. Hand write or type up your findings in your own words.	<u>Research</u> Research Mary Anning using the internet or books. Hand write or type up your findings in your own words.	<u>Fact file</u> Create a fact file about a dinosaur of your choice. You may want to add in fun facts which your classmates might not know!
Creative	<u>Funny bones!</u> Make a model of a dinosaur Use whatever materials you wish.	<u>Pre historic pictures!</u> Create or reproduce a picture depicting a dinosaur's habitat. You could draw, paint, collage, use chalks or use a computer paint package to create your picture.	<u>Fossils</u> Make some dinosaur bones or fossils.

If you have any of your own creative ideas to explore our topic you can complete a task of your own.
