Child Health Matters: Our local NHS has created a free Childrens Health Matters guide for parents and carers. It explains how to treat children at home, when to see a GP or call 111, and when you should seek emergency help.

If your child has a sickness bug (vomiting/diarrhoea), please ensure they have a period of 48hrs without an episode before returning to school.
