

Secondary Admission for September 2024:

Applications for secondary places are open for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2024. Applications can be made at www.essex.gov.uk/admissions and will close on 31st October 2023.



Please also note that if your child is in Receptiony2, you may also apply on the same link for Free school meals as if you are eligible, it does then give you access to HAF which provides extra support during the main holidays.

Illness: In regard to temperatures the NHS advise "If your child has a high temperature, keep them off school until it goes away" With a high temperature being given as 38c or more. If your child has a sickness bug (vomiting/diarrhoea), please ensure they have a period of 48hrs without an episode before returning to school.
